All Fall 2020 courses for the **Coquitlam College Associate of Arts and the University Transfer Program** will be offered online. The facilities are not available to students in-person. Students requesting counselling or academic advice must make an appointment via Zoom by calling the main office number or emailing a counsellor directly. Students will find information on their courses at their Student Portal.

Our **Brookmere Secondary High School Program** will be offered in person. The orientation package will be sent to all high school students' current emails. If you do not receive one, please contact <u>admissions@coquitlamcollege.com</u> High School students and their families can rest assured that the College will follow all guidelines for safety and cleanliness as set out by the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Education as well as WorkSafeBC to offer in-person classes. You can feel confident that every precaution has been taken to ensure that the College is safe.

The **English Studies Program** will be offered in a hybrid system: online for students overseas and in-person for students already in Canada. Students should notify an academic counsellor if they desire to take courses in person rather than remotely.

The College will continue to update the public and staff as the Fall 2020 semester progresses and more guidelines are provided to us by the Provincial Health Officer, the Ministry of Education, and the Ministry of Advanced Education, Skills and Training.

Please note, late registration for University Transfer, Associate Degree and High School courses will end September 14 2020.
