

Safely returning to the Coquitlam College campus

This page provides resources and information to ensure the safety of all our community members.

Only students registered in High School and some English Studies courses can enter the campus after initially being greeted and screened by a Coquitlam College staff member at a designated entry point.

<u>University Transfer/Associate or Arts Degree students must request permission to physically access the campus</u> by making an appointment beforehand by calling the main switchboard at 604-939-6633.

For students in High School/English Studies:

Students will be asked to use hand sanitizer or wash their hands. Masks will be provided to students who arrive on campus without one. Students are required to protect themselves and their classmates by following these tips:

- Maintain physical distancing requirements (minimum 2 m = 6 ft. apart)
- Wear a non-medical mask when in public areas on campus where physical distancing cannot be maintained
- Wash your hands often with soap and water or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Avoid high-touch areas, where possible, or ensure you clean your hands afterwards.
- Sanitize often, every time you touch new surfaces
- Sneeze and cough into your upper sleeve
- If you use a tissue, discard immediately and wash your hands afterward
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth
- Avoid contact with people who are sick
- Do not come on campus if you are sick

DO NOT come to campus if:

- You have not yet completed your mandatory 14-day self-isolation/quarantine
- You are sick. Complete a <u>daily self-assessment</u>
- You have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- You have been outside the country or been in contact with somebody who has been outside the country in the last 14 days
- You are a University Transfer / Associate of Arts Degree student without prior authorization

When visiting the campus:

- Follow all posted safety and directional signage
- Wear a non-medical face mask in public areas or where physical distancing of at least 2m is not
 possible
- Enter the campus only at the designated entry point where you will be greeted and screened by a Coquitlam College staff member
- Use hand sanitizer or wash your hands immediately upon entering
- Report all on-campus illnesses to Security before leaving the campus
- If you are a University Transfer/Associate of Arts Degree student and you have received prior permission to enter the campus, stay only as long as necessary
