Duties and Authority	The SICT will report to the Health and Safety Liaison at the College on matters relating to Self-Isolation and Quarantine monitoring involving newly arrived international students who have been accepted by Coquitlam College.
	The SICT will follow protocols as described in <i>Covid-19 International Student Travel Arrival and Quarantine Guide</i> .
	The Self-Isolation Confirmation Team:
	Ensures students prepare appropriately pre-arrival
	Reviews students' arrival and transportation plans prior to arrival
	Communicates with students upon arrival
	Confirms students' self-isolation
	Monitors students regularly
	Updates Health and Safety Liaison on self-isolation data
	Reports suspected or confirmed violations to Liaison
Membership	The SICT will be comprised of:
	Health and Safety Liaison

Accountability	The SICT will perform in a manner which considers the best interests of the
	College, its staff, its student body, and the community at large.
Meetings	The SICT will meet with the Health and Safety Liaison once a week.
	The Liaison may call more meetings when necessary.

	Minutes of the meetings will be provided to the Executive Council.
