



Q: I am an international student enrolled at Coquitlam College but am still out of country. Can I travel to Canada?

A: Yes you can!

As of October 20, 2020, Coquitlam College is on the approved list of Canadian DLIs with a COVID-19 readiness plan approved by the Province of British Columbia.

Therefore, we are reopen to welcoming international students currently outside Canada and who

- have, or have been approved for, a study permit
- are entering Canada for the specific reason to study

Whether or not your classes are remote or in-person, if you are considering traveling to Canada to resume your studies, it is important that you fulfill the following requirements to be eligible to currently travel to Canada:

1. a valid study permit or a letter of introduction from the Canadian government that shows you were approved for a study permit.
2. a valid letter of acceptance (LOA) from Coquitlam College
3. proof that you have enough money to support yourself in Canada
4. receipt of the [ArriveCAN](#) app where you have detailed your plans for your mandatory 14-day quarantine
5. a copy of your quarantine plan, which you have submitted to Coquitlam College prior to travel

It is important that you have supporting documentation to prove these requirements listed above; A Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) officer will make a final decision on your eligibility to enter Canada when you arrive.

Please submit your self-isolation (quarantine) plan to Coquitlam College before travelling to Canada. Coquitlam College can issue a travel letter to students who have submitted the following two items together along with a copy of your study permit:

Most recent mandatory Government of Canada requirements for travellers to Canada:

- As of November 21, 2020, **air travellers** whose final destination is Canada **will be required to submit their information electronically through the [ArriveCAN](#) app before they board their flight.** This includes travel and contact information, quarantine plan, and COVID-19 symptom self-assessment.
- Travellers must be ready to show their ArriveCAN receipt when seeking entry into Canada; a border services officer will verify that they have submitted their information digitally.
- Travellers who do not submit the required information digitally before boarding their flight could be subject to enforcement action, which can range from verbal warnings to \$1,000 fine.

Like all travelers to Canada, international students exempt from travel restrictions must travel with a non-medical mask or face covering if arriving by air and must isolate for 14 days upon arrival in Canada.
