Appendix A: Public health actions

If a Staff, Student or Other Person who has been in the School is a Confirmed COVID-19 case

Student or staff confirmed to be COVID-19 case



The Principal or Designate will contact the Medical Officer for Fraser Health at 604-930-5404.

Confirmed case interviewed by public health to determine how they were infected and who they were in close contact with while infectious



If confirmed case was not infectious when they attended school, the school will not be contacted.

If confirmed case was infectious while they attended school OR it is determined that they were infected at school, public health will inform the Principal or Designate and

- Request class lists
- Determine if there are any confirmed close contacts based on length of time of exposure and nature of the interaction. Only public health can determine who is a close contact.
- Coordinate with the College to develop and implement a communications plan, including who should be notified, how and when



Confirmed close contacts are asked to self-isolate for 14 days from the last exposure and if symptoms develop, seek testing. If no symptoms develop, return to school after self-isolation period.

Staff and students will be notified if they were potentially exposed
