ONLINE MIDTERM EXAM AND FINAL EXAM

1. Students have read and understand the 2.2.1 Academic Integrity policy.
2. In the given time frame of the exam, students must start and complete the exam with one device.
3. Only use instructor approved materials for your exam: no online searching or use of other electronic devices, and books. Possession or use of unapproved materials or information not authorized by the instructor is considered academic misconduct.
4. Communication of any kind, with anyone other than the instructor during an exam is not permitted, including texting, chat apps, email, and talking.
5. All the web browser tabs must be closed during the online exam except MyCC.
6. Students are not permitted to capture the image of exam materials.
7. Students may not participate in an exam if they arrive 30 minutes after the exam started.
8. Students who arrive late will not be given extra time to complete the exam.
9. Only the student taking the exam may be present in the room.
10. Students must logout of exam once they have submitted the exam.
