In compliance with the British Columbia Tobacco and Vapour Products Act, Coquitlam College is a "tobacco/vapour products free" campus. Students will be advised at the beginning of each semester and on a regular basis during the semester that smoking or vaping on campus is prohibited. Students who are found to have breached the smoking or vaping regulations may be subject to one or more of the following disciplinary measures:

- Warning or reprimand
- Student Conduct Contract
- Restriction or prohibition of access or use
- Probation
- Suspension
- Expulsion
- Discretionary measure

To comply with the British Columbia Tobacco and Vapour Products Act, Coquitlam College has posted no-smoking/no-vaping signs around the campus. The no-smoking and no-vaping policy is also published in the student handbook and discussed at student orientation session. Coquitlam College actively informs students of anti-smoking practices during safety week.

Coquitlam College staff, security and maintenance discuss the smoking and vaping regulations with students and inform them that they must leave the campus to smoke or vape. All the Senior Secondary staff will inform their classes regarding the BC Government regulations of the no-smoking and no-vaping policy on campus.
