#### **Transfer Credits for Associate of Arts Graduates**

Associate of Arts graduates will be granted 30 UVic units (60 CC credits) of transfer credit if admitted into a degree program.

**Note:** Students receiving 30 credits of transfer credit for completion of the Associates of Arts degree are still obligated to fulfill all prerequisites in the degree program to which they are admitted.



## UVIC - Bachelor of Arts - Philosophy Year 2

- Admission is assessed by a GPA of the applicant's 8 most recent transferrable courses, where the minimum requirement is a 2.0 on UVIC's 9pt. grade scale (60-64%).
- <u>English Proficiency Requirement</u>: Met through either: 1 or more transferrable courses of Post-Secondary English, **or**, an IELTS score of 6.5 with no component below 6.0.

#### **Additional Notes:**

- International students are required to complete COM 206C (Business English and Communications Level III) and/or COM 290 (Introduction to Canadian Business) as mandatory courses in January of their second year, unless otherwise specified by a BCom advisor.
- BCom applicants for direct-entry into BCom core must submit a Request for Registration form in October of their second year to be added to these courses on a first-come, first-served basis. It is the applicant's responsibility to consult with an advisor to determine whether or not they need to take these courses.
- For transfer into Year 2 of the BCom program, preference will be given to applicants who have completed at least two required courses by the application deadline.

# **Grade Requirements**

- A minimum GPA of a B- must be achieved in all required courses shown above, and a minimum C+ grade must be achieved in the courses listed above.
- All BCom students must complete the pre-commerce requirements listed above and meet the minimum GPA conditions outlined below in order to progress or transfer into year 3 BCom core.
- English Proficiency requirement, met through either: 1 or more transferrable courses of Post-Secondary English, or, an IELTS score of 6.5 with no component below 6.0.
- Two required courses for transferring into the Bachelor of Commerce Degree program is UVIC's ATWP 250 and COM 200 which currently do not have transferable equivalents offered at Coquitlam College. Please see an Academic Advisor to discuss alternative options regarding these requirements.

#### **Personal Submission**

Applicants are also required to submit a personal submission as part of the admissions process. Your personal submission should reflect your values and provide depth into what you offer as a BCom candidate. Think about who you are and why you want to join the BCom program, then answer the following question:

- How will your lived experiences help make positive change in our campus community?
- Minimum 250 words in paragraph format.

# **Grade Requirements**

- Successful completion of the courses listed above, with a minimum C (60%) grade, including CSC 115 or 116 at UVic, which at this time, does not have transferrable equivalent offered at Coquitlam College at this time. When offered, Coquitlam College's CSCI 200 and 250 are respectively equivalent to UVIC's CSC 116 and 115 Please see an Academic Advisor to discuss alternative options regarding this requirement.
- A minimum C grade in all program required CSC, SENG (Software Engineering) and MATH courses.
- A minimum C+ (65%) average on your most recent 8 courses; and must be in Good Academic Standing.
- English Proficiency requirement, met through either: 1 or more transferrable courses of Post-Secondary English, or an IELTS score of 6.5 with no component below 6.0.
